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WHAT IS BASIC SKILLS PLUS?

Basic Skills Plus is a tuition waiver program planned to serve Basic Skills students, who have achieved Adult Secondary level, Title II National Reporting System levels, in either math **or** reading, and who are concurrently enrolled in courses providing employability skills, job specific, occupational, technical skills or developmental education.





A BASIC SKILLS PLUS STUDENT...

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is concurrently enrolled (same semester or term at same institution)



is functioning at Adult Secondary level in math OR reading



is a Basic Skills student



is a documented student




does NOT have a high school diploma or recognized equivalent

UPDATE COMING SOON Students

"Students are eligible for waivers only in occupational extension and/or curriculum courses. Basic Skills Plus Waivers should not exceed 12 credit hours for curriculum courses or a single qualifying Continuing Education (CE) course. A qualifying CE course is one that aligns with a credential and is scheduled for more than 96 hours".

WHAT YOU DO NOT NEED

System Office BSP approval

While you need to submit an IET template to collect MSG for an IET, you do not need to submit any additional documentation to the state to use the Basic Skills Plus tuition waiver.
