Additionally, enrollment soared! College and Career Readiness served 62,302 students across North Carolina – a 34% increase over 2022–23.







Enrollment & MSGs

We are experiencing a record year! Preliminary PY 23-24 data shows the state with a measurable skill gain (MSG) percentage of **47.8%**, which exceeds our target of 43.6%. North Carolina has not met the federal MSG goal since PY 18-19. CCR also served **62,302 students** for PY 23-24, which is our highest enrollment to date!

What a wonderful way to ring in the new programmatic year. Congratulations everyone! This is well-earned success.







2024-25 Title II Monitoring Information

Providers received details regarding program monitoring the week of July 15, 2024. Selected providers received official monitoring information via email from Brandy Brown, Title II Monitoring and Reporting Specialist. Additionally, providers received official Risk Assessment communication from Carla Parnell, Title II Grants Administrator.

HSE Office/CCR Assessment Updates

On June 20, 2024, OCTAE announced NRS approval for two new assessment series from TABE: **TABE 13/14** and **TABE CLAS-E Forms C/D**. TABE 13/14 is approved for use with ABE/ASE students, and CLAS-E C/D is approved for use with ESL students. The NRS has approved both assessments for a *three-year period*, with their current expiration dates set for *June 20, 2027*.

The CCR Assessment Office is in the process of revising North Carolina's assessment policy to approve these new test series for use in our state. Providers will be informed when the new manual is approved by OCTAE. Additionally, a request has been submitted for the new assessments to be programmed into ADVANSYS, pending OCTAE approval of the new assessment policy.

As a reminder to providers who use TABE, both TABE 11/12 and CLAS-E Forms A/B have had their approval extended to June 30, 2025; this is meant to provide a sufficient sunset period for concluding the use of the outgoing assessments and transitioning to the new series. The CCR Assessment Office will work with providers to facilitate a smooth transition. Please contact Jenifer Bean (beanj@nccommunitycolleges.edu) with any questions or technical assistance requests.
