The North Carolina Community College System is moving forward with reviewing a new data and analytics system to support the functions of Title II. The Request For Proposal (RFP) for the new data management system requires vendors to produce a system that will track, report, query and analyze data needed for Title II reporting.

In an effort to be inclusive, a cross functional RFP committee has been convened to review and evaluate the RFP proposals. The committee includes the following Subject Matter Experts (SMEs): College and Career Readiness (CCR) Directors, CCR Data Managers, state and local Community College Information Technology staff, and NCCCS staff.
